

Tadeusz Wroński Foundation for Violin and 1ST Adam Czartoryski High School announces
The 2ND Paganini in Puławy Violin Competition,
Puławy 21-22 February 2023

The Rules

1. The Competition hearings will be held in the Concert Hall of Adam Czartoryski High School Concert Hall in Puławy.
2. The Competition is open for violinist from all countries. Candidates will be admitted to the Competition on the basis of the written recommendation by the professor he/she is working with during the 2nd Puławy and Violin Master Course.
3. Candidates not participating in the Course will be admitted. In their case a written recommendation from their regular teacher or school shall be required. They will also be obliged to pay an inscription fee of 40 Euro, which can be reimbursed **only** if the candidate is not admitted to the Competition. The fee shall be paid to the Foundation Bank account: **P K O Bank Polski S.A. 4. The number of candidates is limited. For those meeting the conditions mentioned in p. 2 and 3 the order of submission of the application will be decisive.
5. The order of performance in the Competition will be established by drawing the letter of the alphabet (on Opening Ceremony Concert 21st of February).
6. This Competition is a one-stages event for all participants in each age category.
7. Grand Prix of the Competition is a master violin bow made by Ms. Magdalena Sapeta – (Poland/ Spain), who made this bow specially for this event. An additional prize of PLN 500 was funded by the Association Authors of ZAiKS. It will go to the best performer of a piece by a Polish composer written after 1945 (G. Bacewicz, A. Malawski, K. Penderecki, W. Lutosławski and others).
8. The prizes will be awarded in three age groups.
 - I. Elementary school children up to 14 years of age;
 - II. Middle school students and High school students up to 19 years of age;
 - III. College or university level music establishment
9. The decisions concerning the prizes shall be made by the International Jury of the Competition chaired by Professor Slawomir Tomasik.
10. The prize winners will have the titles of laureates of the *2nd Paganini in Puławy Violin Competition*.
11. The application of the candidates **not** participating in the 3RD Puławy and the Violin Master Course shall provide the following data:
 - Name and surname
 - Date and place of birth
 - Short artistic c.v. and photo
 - Address of residence phone number and mailing and e-mail address
 - The pieces the candidate will perform at the Competition
 - Proof of payment of 40 Euro
 - Two signatures: one under an **Application form**, the second – **Consent to personal data processing document** (located below Application Form RODO).

The application of the candidates not participating in the Course as well as the payment should be sent to the bureau of the Competition: wronski.fundacja.skrzypce@gmail.com **by 3 of January 2023 at the latest.**

12. The organizers will inform the candidates of their admission (or not) to the Competition by **5 January, 2023.** The inscription fee of the candidates not admitted shall be reimbursed.
13. The Competition will close with a gala recital of the laureates (22.01.2023). The prize-winners and those awarded with distinctions are obliged to participate in it without a fee. The program of the recital will be decided by the Jury. The director of this Competition has the right to decide whether any performance in the Competition may be: broadcast, registered (tape or film) and, subsequently, presented to the public photographed (in compliance with the rules applied to photo taking at indoor public events on all social networks), without financial compensation to participants. By signing the filled application form the candidate states that he/she has read and understood the Rules above.

Program¹

Group 1: children up to 14 yrs. of age

1. One of Etude or Caprice of the candidate's choice
2. Second Etude or Caprice **or**
G.Ph. Telemann – 1st or 2nd movement from one of the 12 Fantasies **or**
a piece of up to 6 min., for violin solo or for violin and piano;

Group 2 – students from 15 to 19 yrs. of age

1. One of etude or caprice of the candidate's choice.
2. Second etude or caprice of the candidate's choice **or**
G.Ph. Telemann – 1st and 2nd movement from one of the 12 Fantasies **or**
J.S. Bach – one movement of one Sonata or Partita (except Fugue or Ciaccona) **or**
virtuoso piece up to 9 min. for violin solo or for violin and piano

Group 3. – students and graduates of a university level music establishment to 30 yrs. of age

1. One of etude or caprice of the candidate's choice.
2. Second etude or caprice of the candidate's choice **or**
virtuoso piece up to 11 min. for violin solo or for violin and piano

Attention: The pieces shall be played from memory.
