

**Professor MAGDALENA REZLER – Freiburg, (25.07 – 12.08)**



A graduate of the Music Academy in Warsaw, class of profs. T. Wroński i S. Kawalla. A laureate of the International Violin Competition in Bordeaux, the Queen Elisabeth of Belgium Competition in Brussels. J. Thibaud Competition in Paris and C. Flesch Competition in London. She performs as a soloist and in chamber music ensembles in Europe, USA and Asia, and has made a number of recordings for radio and tv broadcasters in Poland and abroad. For 13 years she was the leader of a string quartet, which received an award at the international Competition in Budapest. She worked with outstanding instrumentalists and chamber music groups. A concertmistress of the Chamber Music Orchestra of the National Philharmonia, under Karol Teutsch, performing also as a soloist. Often appears in chamber music concerts in

Germany and Switzerland, working with outstanding performers, f. ex. „Freiburger Barock Solisten”.

Violin teacher and professor first AT the AMFC In Warsaw, Since 1991 professor at the Hochschule fur Musik in Freiburg. Teaches masterclasses in Europe, Asia and USA. Member of jury panels in many international competition. Involved with the Wronski competition since its beginning in 1990. She was the organizing secretary of the very first competition, and a juror in all the successive ones.

The latest CD by M. Rezler-Niesiołowska „Con bravura e sentimento”, containing Polish virtuoso pieces for violin and orchestra, recorded together with her husband, conductor Maciej Niesiołowski was extremely well received.
